

Necessities:

About 40 grams cotton for the body.

About 20 grams cotton for the head.

A remnant cotton scarf

Filling.

Crochet hook 2.5.

needle

0.5 mm safety eyelets

The pattern:

Head

Begin with the color of the head

1 Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

2 Hook 2 sc in every st (12)

3 Hook 2 sc in every 2nd st (18)

4 Hook 2 sc in every 3rd st (24)

5 Hook 2 sc in every 4th st (30)

6 Hook 2 sc in every 5th st (36)

7 Hook 2 sc in every 6th st (42)

8 - 14 Hook 42 sc (42)

15 Hook every 6th and 7th st together (36)

16 Hook every 5th and 6th st together (30)

17 hook every 4th and 5th st together (24)

18 Hook every 3rd and 4th st together (18)

19 Hook every 2nd and 3rd st together (12)

Fill the head

Fasten off and leaving a tail for sewing

Cap

Begin with the color of the body

1 Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

2 Hook 2 sc in every st (12)

3 Hook 2 sc in every 2nd st (18)

4 Hook 2 sc in every 3rd st (24)

5 Hook 2 sc in every 4th st (30)

6 Hook 2 sc in every 5th st (36)

7 Hook 2 sc in every 6th st (42)

8 - 17 Hook 42 sc (42)

Fasten off and leaving a tail for sewing

Arm - (Make 2 pcs)

Start with the same color as the head

1 Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

2 Hook 2 sc in every 2nd st (9)

3 Hook 2 sc in every 3rd st (12)

4 Hook 6 sc in 6 st, Hook 3 dc in st, Hook 5 sc in last 5 st (14)

5 Hook 6 sc in 6 st, 2tog, Hook 6 sc in last 6 st (13)

6 Hook 13 sc (13)

Change to the color of the body and fill the hands on

7 - 15 Hook 13 sc (13)

16 Hook 4 sc in 4 st, 2tog, Hook 5 in last 5 st (11)

17 Hook 4 sc in 4 st, 2tog, Hook 5 in last 5 st (10)

18 - 26 Hook 10 sc (10)

Fasten off and leaving a tail for sewing

Leg - (Make 2 pcs)

1 Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

2 Hook 2 sc in every st (12)

3 Hook 2 sc in every 2nd st (18)

4 Hook 18 sc in back loops st (18)

5 Hook 18 sc (18)

6 Hook 7 sc, 2tog, 2tog, Hook 7sc (16)

7 Hook 7 sc, 2tog, Hook 7sc (15)

8 Hook 7 sc, 2tog, Hook 7sc (14)

9 – 11 Hook 14 sc (14)

* Possibly change color if you want to make boots

12 Hook 3 sc in 3rd st, Hook 2sc in 4th st, Hook 6 sc in next 6 st, Hook 2sc in 11th st, Hook 3 sc in last 3 st (16)

13 - 15 Hook 16 sc (16)

PAY ATTENTION!!! Attaches one bone. At the 2nd leg we go between the legs together and feathered hooks to the body. Fill the legs on.

Body

The legs are now hooked to each other.

Put the two legs together so that the feet pointing slightly outward.

1 Hook the leg together with 1 sc for a round (32)

Continuing to crochet the body.

2 Hook 7 sc, 2sc in next st, Hook 16 sc, 2 sc in next st, Hook 7 sc (34)

3 Hook 8 sc, 2sc in next st, Hook 16 sc, 2 sc in next st, Hook 7 sc (36)

4 - 6 Hook 36 sc (36)

7 Hook 9 sc, 2sc in next st, Hook 16 sc, 2 sc in next st, Hook 9 sc (38)

8 – 17 Hook 38 sc (38)

18 Hook 9 sc, 2tog, Hook 16 sc, 2tog, Hook 9 sc (36)

19 - 20 Hook 36 sc (36)

21 Hook 9 sc, 2tog, Hook 14 sc, 2tog, Hook 9 sc (34)

22 Hook 34 sc (34)

23 Hook 9 sc, 2tog, Hook 12 sc, 2tog, Hook 9 sc (32)

24 Hook 32 sc (32)

25 Hook 9 sc, 2tog, Hook 10 sc, 2tog, Hook 9 sc (30)

26 Hook 30 sc (30)

27 Hook 8 sc, 2tog and repeat 3 times (27)

28 Hook 7 sc, 2tog and repeat 3 times (24)

29 Hook 24 sc (24)

30 Hook 6sc, 2tog and repeat 3 times (21)

31 Hook 5sc, 2tog and repeat 3 times (18)

32 Hook 18 sc (18)

32 Hook 4sc, 2tog and repeat 3 times (15)

33 Hook 15 sc (15)

Fill the body

Fasten off and leaving a tail for sewing

Ears - (Make 2 pcs)

Begin with the color of the face

1 Make a magic ring of 6 sc (6)

2 2 sc in every 6 st (12)

Fasten off

Use hat color (make 2 pcs)

1 Make a magic ring of 6 sc (6)

2 2 sc in every 6 st (12)

3 Hook 1 sc and 2sc in next st (18)

Hook the 2 color ear face to face together with:

Hook 6 sc, 2 sl st, 1sc, 4 picot stich (4 noodles) and closes with sl st.

Fasten off and leaving a tail for sewing

Tail

- 1 Make a magic ring of 4 sc (4)
- 2 Hook 1 sc, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (6)
- 3 Hook 1 sc in next 2 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (8)
- 4 Hook 1 sc in next 3 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (10)
- 5 Hook 1 sc in next 4 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (12)
- 6 Hook 1 sc in next 5 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (14)
- 7 Hook 1 sc in next 6 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (16)
- 8 Hook 1 sc in next 7 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (18)
- 9 Hook 1 sc in next 8 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (20)
- 10 Hook 1 sc in next 9 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (22)
- 11 Hook 1 sc in next 10 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (24)
- 12 Hook 1 sc in next 11 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (26)
- 13 Hook 1 sc in next 12 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (28)
- 14 Hook 1 sc in next 13 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (30)
- 15 Hook 1 sc in next 14 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (32)
- 16 Hook 1 sc in next 15 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (34)
- 17 Hook 1 sc in next 16 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (36)
- 18 Hook 1 sc in next 17 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (38)

19 Hook 1 sc in next 18 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (40)

20 Hook 1 sc in next 19 st, and 2 sc in next st, repeat 2 times (42)

Fasten off

For the spines use the description of the original lalylala Dirk pattern.

Scarf:

I hooked solve about 50 to 60 and crochet back with half sticks. Once unloaded and then a row of half sticks.

Spines:

Pin a straight line from head to the tip of the tail, this mark you where you need to solve stabbing places. Start at the tip of the tail to the edge of the cap.

Make once discharging and crochet 3 sticks in a stitch, finish off with a half-fast.

2 skip unloading and hook back three sticks down, finish off with a half-fast
